The Writer Within

January 25th : Every Wednesday from 2-4:30 PM for 4 weeks at the Academy

Daryllynn Starr Rank, writer and registered Psychologist recognizes that creativity is a complex and endlessly challenging process in which writers regularly hit stumbling blocks, barriers, dry periods and the inability to go as deeply into their writing as is desired or necessary. Her focus during these programs is to help participants determine what enhances their creative processes as well as discover the factors that inhibit creativity. The workshop is highly interactive and is held at the Academy. Cost for 4 sessions is \$180.00. Optional additional Sessions.

Great Decision

January 30th : Every Monday from 2-3:30 PM for 8 weeks at the Academy

This program sponsored by the Foreign Policy Association takes the learner beyond the headlines by providing a look at significant and far-reaching challenges facing the world. This study group empowers the participants to discuss global issues shaping the US policy in the world. Each topic is approach by facilitator Jill Sima in an objective and challenging manner. Topics include Middle East realignment, Promoting Democracy, Mexico, Cybersecurity, Exit from Afghanistan and Iraq, State of the Oceans, Indonesia and Energy Geopolitics.
