

Bathroom Training Policy (for 3-4 years old only)

PK3/PK4 children enrolled in The Academy at Ocean Reef must be fully bathroom trained before enrollment. Your adherence to this policy helps ensure a positive learning environment for your child and the other children in their class.

In order for your child to be enrolled at The Academy at Ocean Reef, he or she must be fully bathroom trained. A child is considered to be bathroom trained if he or she:

- Can tell the teacher he/she needs to go to the restroom.
- Is able to go to the restroom on his/her own. This includes being able to remove clothing, sitting on the toilet, wiping himself/herself, putting clothing back on, flushing the toilet, and washing and drying his/her hands.
- Is aware of the need to use the toilet without reminders from the teachers (although, teachers do make requests of children at various times of the day).
- Will not be in diapers or pull-ups at all. He/she must be in underwear.

If a teacher is spending their time with bathroom accidents, it disrupts the learning environment for the other children in the classroom.

We are mindful that accidents occur from time to time, and for that reason we ask that you keep a change of clothing at school.

However, if your child has bathroom accidents on a consistent basis while they are in school, we do not consider your child to be fully bathroom trained and we will have to consider withdrawing your child from The Academy at Ocean Reef.

- 2. The Admissions Committee will not consider the application until this application is completed and submitted with the signature as indicated below, and the nonrefundable **application fee of \$195 has been paid**.
- 3. The Academy at Ocean Reef's acceptance of an applicant for the next school year is contingent upon successful completion of the applicant's current grade.
- 4. Within ten days of notification of acceptance, applicants must return the completed enrollment contract with the non-refundable tuition deposit stated in the contract. This deposit is applied directly to the total tuition and cannot be refunded except under the conditions stated on the contract.
- 5. A vital part of The Academy at Ocean Reef's mission is the development of character and social responsibility, therefore, each student's conduct, both at school and in the community, concerns the school. Conduct or attitudes which the faculty and administration consider seriously detrimental to other students or to the school may be considered grounds for dismissal.
- 6. A student's success and happiness in the school environment depends greatly upon positive parental support of school policies. Your cooperation and support are necessary and expected.

The Academy at Ocean Reef, Inc., originally The Schoolhouse at Ocean Reef, Inc., was founded in 1989 by a group of Ocean Reef Club members seeking a quality independent school within the Ocean Reef community. The school opened as a preschool and is now fully accredited with students from toddler through eighth grade. The Academy enrolls children of members of the Ocean Reef Club, the employees of the Ocean Reef Club, businesses and homeowners within Ocean Reef, and highly qualified students from communities that are adjacent to Ocean Reef.

Faculty

All Lead teachers possess a bachelors or masters degree. All faculty members are dedicated to implementing the philosophy and goals of The Academy to prepare students for their high school years and beyond. Our faculty is an integral part of the school community. In addition to hosting conferences and workshops, our faculty love to join in and participate in school fundraising events and family dinners.

Dress Code

The school uniform is required for all students from Toddler through Eighth Grade. Information is available in the School Office. Students are expected to be well-groomed and neat in appearance.

Activities

After school activities are provided by the Ocean Reef Club. The Academy sponsors "life-long" sports including tennis, golf, sailing, swimming, and pickleball. Our After School Child Care program is also available to all students on Monday-Thursday from 3:15pm-5:30pm and on Friday from 2:30pm-5:30pm.

School Hours & Calendar

The school year begins in September and commences in June. When school is in session, the building opens at 8:00am and upon arrival, students must report to their classroom/ homeroom teacher. At 8:15am, all classes proceed to the front of the building for the Morning Flag. Classes convene following the Flag Ceremony, and dismissal for Monday-Thursday is 3:15pm and on Friday at 2:30pm. A 5 half-day program option is available for Toddler—PreK 4 students. It begins at 8:00am and dismisses at 12:00pm.

Application Process

- Families should schedule a tour and interview with the Head of School by contacting the Admissions Office at 305-367-2409 or via email at admissions@oracademy.org
- The enclosed Application for Admission should be completed and returned to The Academy with the application fee. A separate application and fee must be submitted for each child.
- Candidates for admission to grades K-8 are required to have school transcripts, rec form and test records forwarded to The Academy.
- If the student is accepted, an Enrollment Contract will be issued and must be completed and returned to The Academy, along with a non-refundable enrollment deposit, in order to finalize their place in the class.
- Once enrolled, families will receive an acceptance packet containing important forms and requirements for the school year.

Prior to the first day of school, all students (Toddler through Grade 8) are required to have on file the following documents:

- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Original/current Florida Certificate of Immunization-form DH680
- Original/current Florida Student Health Examination-form DH3040
- Copy of transcript, progress and/or report card, and testing results (if applicable)
- Emergency Contact Information
- Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) required forms for all Toddler and Pre K students
- All Academy students and parents are required to read the Student Handbook and sign the "Acknowledgement of Acceptable Use Policy" and the "Acknowledgement and Receipt of Student Handbook."

- Tuition must be paid in advance for one month or less
- Seasonal students who attend The Academy more than 12 weeks will be considered full time and charged the full-time tuition.
