Mission Statement

History

The Academy at Ocean Reef, Inc., originally The Schoolhouse at Ocean Reef, Inc., was founded in 1989 by a group of Ocean Reef Club members seeking a quality independent school within the Ocean Reef community. The school opened as a preschool and is now fully accredited with students from toddler through eighth grade. The Academy enrolls children of members of the Ocean Reef Club, the employees of the Ocean Reef Club, businesses and homeowners within Ocean Reef, and highly qualified students from communities that are adjacent to Ocean Reef.

Faculty

Each member of the faculty is qualified, experienced, and dedicated in implementing the philosophy and goals of The Academy to prepare students for their high school years and beyond. The teaching faculty includes specialized instructors in Physical Education, Athletics, Music, Art, Modern Languages, Library, Technology, and Science.

Dress Code

The school uniform is required for all students from Toddler through eighth grade. Information is available in the School Office. Students are expected to be well-groomed and neat in appearance.

Activities

After school activities are provided by the Ocean Reef Club. The Academy sponsors "*life-long*" sports including tennis, golf, sailing, swimming, and pickleball. After School Child Care programs are also available to all students on Monday-Thursday from 3:30pm-5:30pm and on Friday from 2:30pm-5:30pm.

School Hours

The school building opens at 7:55am and upon arrival, students must report to their classroom/homeroom teacher. At 8:15am, all classes proceed to the front of the building for the Morning Flag. Classes convene following the Flag Ceremony, and dismissal for Monday-Thursday is 3:15pm and on Friday at 2:20pm.

Application Process

- Families should schedule a tour and interview with the Head of School by contacting the Admissions Office at 305-367-2409 or via email at admissions@oracademy.org
- The enclosed Application for Admission should be completed and returned to The Academy with the application fee. A separate application and fee must be submitted for each child.
- Candidates for admission to grades K-8 are required to have school transcripts and test records forwarded to The Academy.
- If the student is accepted, an Enrollment Contract will be issued and must be completed and returned to The Academy, along with a non-refundable enrollment deposit, in order to finalize their place in the class.
- Once enrolled, families will receive an acceptance packet containing important forms and requirements for the school year.

Prior to the first day of school, all students (Toddler through grade 8) are required to have on file the following documents:

- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Original/current Florida Certificate of Immunization-form DH680
- Original/current Florida Student Health Examination-form DH3040
- Copy of transcript, progress and/or report card, and testing results (if applicable)
- Emergency Contact Information
- All Academy students and parents are required to read the Student Handbook and sign the "Acknowledgement of Acceptable Use Policy" and the "Acknowledgement and Receipt of Student Handbook."
